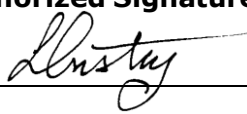

### INFORMATION (not part of the 2.4 NOD Class Certificate)

The following information is an extract of the 2.4 NOD Class Rules – please check the International 2.4mR Class Association website for a copy of the current 2.4 NOD Class Rules.

The 2.4 NOD Class Rules are Closed Class Rules, anything not specifically allowed by these rules is prohibited.

### VALIDITY OF CERTIFICATE

A certificate becomes invalid upon:

- ❖ Significant repair or replacement to the hull, keel or rudder and the change to any items recorded on the certificate in accordance with the 2.4 NOD Class Rules
- ❖ Withdrawal by the ICA
- ❖ The issue of a new certificate

### BOAT ELIGIBILITY

For a boat to be eligible for racing, it shall comply with the 2.4 NOD Class Rules.

The boat shall:

- ❖ Be in compliance with the 2.4 NOD Class Rules
- ❖ Have a valid 2.4 NOD certificate
- ❖ Have valid certification marks in accordance with the 2.4mR Class Rules
- ❖ Have been certified according to the 2.4mR Class Rules
- ❖ Have a valid ICA Buoyancy Certificate in accordance with the 2.4 NOD Class Rules
