Notice of Race (NoR)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Prescription of National Authority do not apply.
- 1.3 2.4 mR World and Continental Championship Management Manual will apply.
- 1.4 International 2.4mR Class Rules will apply.
- 1.5 For those competing in 2.4 Norlin One Design Class (2.4 NOD) Division, the 2.4 Norlin One Design Class Rules will also apply.
- 1.6 Appendix T, Arbitration will be in effect.
- 1.7 In accordance with RRS G3, a boat chartered or loaned for this event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.
- 1.8 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a). [DP] is defined in the RRS Introduction.
- 1.9 Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.
- 1.10 Bow identifiers will be assigned by Organizing Authority (OA) and given to each participating boat at check-in. They shall be affixed to the hull according to the instructions provided by the OA.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in and on the registration website prior to the event.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://www.manage2sail.com/e/event/24mRwc2023#!/onb?tab=documents&classId=24mR> . A courtesy notice board is located on the South wall of the Clubhouse next to the main entrance.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make or receive voice or data transmissions that are not available to all boats.
- 3.3 A VHF radio channel will be designated in the sailing instructions for the race committee to communicate with support vessels for safety and other purposes.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International 2.4mR Class.
- 4.2 A maximum of 100 entries in order of complete registration will be accepted.
- 4.3 [NP] [DP] World Sailing Eligibility shall apply. Each competitor shall be registered as a World Sailing Sailor on <https://www.sailing.org/sailors/world-sailing-profile/> .
- 4.4 [NP] [DP] Competitors shall be affiliated with a World Sailing Member National Authority. These are listed on the World Sailing website <https://www.sailing.org/inside-world-sailing/organisation/our-family/national-federations/> .
- 4.5 [NP] [DP] All competitors shall be current members of their National Class Association or a member of the International Class Association.
- 4.6 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at on-site check-in.

- 4.7 In addition, the following categories will be awarded:
- 4.7.1 Competitors sailing 2.4 Norlin One Design Class Boats
 - 4.7.2 Master (age 55 – 64 on August 5, 2023)
 - 4.7.3 Grand Master (age 65 and older on August 5, 2023)
 - 4.7.4 Youth (age under 30 on August 5, 2023)
 - 4.7.5 Rookie (sailing first World Championship)
 - 4.7.6 Female
 - 4.7.7 Sailors with disabilities
- 4.8 Registration shall be completed online at <https://www.manage2sail.com/e/event/24mRwc2023>. Support persons see NoR 12 below.
- 4.9 Registration is complete when:
- 4.9.1 Registration at manage2sail has been completed.
 - 4.9.2 Payment has been completed online.
 - 4.9.3 Proof of insurance has been supplied to the OA.
 - 4.9.4 Measurement certificates have been provided to the OA (see NoR 8.1).
- Required documents can be attached to the registration form at manage2sail.
- 4.10 The last day for online registration is June 30, 2023. Additional entries will be at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority.

- 5.2 All fees are EUR. All dates and times are Eastern Europe summertime (UTC +3).
- 5.3 The entry fee includes opening ceremony with appetizers and beer, food and refreshments after racing each day, closing awards ceremony and closing dinner.
- 5.4 The entry fee for competitors and support persons also includes boat and trailer storage as well as container storage. See Additional Information.
- 5.5 Extra social tickets can be purchased for 120 € during registration or onsite.

6 ADVERTISING

[DP] All boats may be required to display identification numbers and/or sponsor advertising for the duration of the event in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.4. These items will be supplied free of charge by the Organizing Authority at check-in.

- 7.1 All boats shall be afloat by August 1, 17.00 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with written permission of the jury.
 - 7.2 Up to four races may be sailed in a day provided the regatta is not more than one race ahead of schedule.
- 8 [DP] MEASUREMENT AND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION
- 8.1 All boats shall provide to the Organizing Authority (OA) both the valid 2.4mR Measurement Certificate and Buoyancy Certificate.
 - 8.2 In addition, for those competing in the NMKIII OD Division, the 2.4 Norlin One Design Certificate must also be provided to the OA.
 - 8.3 A sign-up list indicating when individual boats should be available for measurement will be posted on the courtesy notice board.
 - 8.4 At a minimum, the following measurements are planned to be taken:
 - 8.4.1 Weight of all boats shall be checked against Measurement Certificate as stated in Rule C.5.1.
 - 8.4.2 The World Sailing Plaque Number shall be checked against the Measurement Certificate as stated in Rule B.5.
 - 8.4.3 A maximum of 3 jibs and 2 mainsails may be registered. The J and E measures respectively given on the certification mark (Rule G.2.2) shall be checked against the Measurement Certificate. The sails shall be marked by a stamp of the OA. Only sails with Certification Marks (Rule B.2) by the sail makers or an Official Measurer shall be stamped.
 - 8.4.4 National letters and sail numbers will be checked for conformance with the measurement certificate (subject to NoR 1.6 exemption).
 - 8.4.5 The mast datum point punch mark shall be checked for compliance with Rule F.2.3.
 - 8.4.6 Flotation marks on the hull according to Rule D.9.2 as well as marks on spars according to Rule F.2.2 shall be visually checked.
 - 8.4.7 The following safety devices shall be checked: Manual pump according to Rule D.9.1(a)(2); towing rope according to Rule C.4.2(a)(1); and fitting for towing rope according to Rule D.9.1(a)(1).
 - 8.5 Additional measurement checks for NMKIII OD boats may be taken
 - 8.6 Measurement checks and inspections for rule compliance may be made at any time at the discretion and direction of the Race Committee or Technical Committee.
- 9 VENUE
- 9.1 The regatta site is Näsijärvi Sailing Club, Jänissaarekatu 14, 33410 Tampere, Finland
 - 9.2 Races will be sailed on Lake Näsijärvi east of Näsijärvi Sailing Club
- 10 COURSES
- 10.1 The course to be sailed will be a windward/leeward with offset and leeward gate.
 - 10.2 The target time for each race will be 60minutes.
- 11 SCORING
- 11.1 A maximum of ten (10) races will be sailed.
 - 11.2 Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a World Championship.
 - 11.3 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - 11.4 When six (6) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - 11.5 When nine (9) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS
- 12.1 Support vessel drivers shall register online at <https://nsailing.fi/24mrwc2023/fees/> (purchase support boat and driver entry fee) and check-in with the OA to receive safety and rescue assignments and identification flag.
 - 12.2 Support vessels shall display their National Flag and the identification flag at all times during the races.
- 13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY
- Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race.

14 [DP] [NP] INSURANCE

- 14.1 Each participating boat shall hold adequate third-party insurance (EUR 300 000). It is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner or owner representatives to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to competing in the event.
- 14.2 Proof of Insurance shall be provided at the time of online Registration.

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 The World Cup Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner.
- 15.2 Prizes will also be given to:
- 15.2.1 Top five competitors
 - 15.2.2 Top three competitors sailing 2.4 NOD Division
 - 15.2.3 Top Female
 - 15.2.4 Top Master
 - 15.2.5 Top Grand Master
 - 15.2.6 Top Youth
 - 15.2.7 Top Rookie
 - 15.2.8 Top sailor with disabilities

16 [DP] [NP] CODE OF CONDUCT

- 16.1 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official.
- 16.2 Boats not racing shall avoid the area where boats are racing and any official boats.
