





- Flexible position of the race courses in the direct vicinity of the shore.








ONSHORE

- Infrastructure of the Olympic Sailing Center Kiel-Schilksee will be used, which provides sufficient parking spaces, halls for measurement, berthing with guarded access, facilities and celebrating locations; very good traffic connection to downtown Kiel.
- The *Regattahaus* in Kiel-Schilksee will be used for race office, jury meetings and media center for press conferences (existing technical equipment, high speed Internet, WiFi, e.g.).
- Accommodation and transport infrastructure: Near-by, sufficient rooms and space are available for all visitors and sailors; Kiel is very approachable via all means of transports.




